In looking to see the people of God about the work of the Father, we are busy challenging our people to be in the community, reaching out with the message of Christ Jesus.

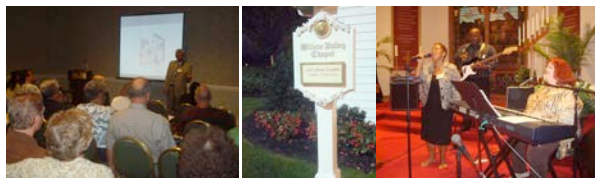

FGA Begins Domestic Missions Efforts for Church Pioneering Ministries

July 2011 was a very special month, in that, Full Gospel Assemblies committed to a new Domestic Missions program of support to pioneering Church ministry in the USA. Pastor Donald Schiemant, Regional Area Representative for FGA's NE Region, presided over the July 16th inaugural service for the Ranch of Hope Community Church of Williamstown, NY, pastored by Kevin and Kim Donahue. Chairman Simeon Strauser was in attendance for the official dedication of the facility unto the Lord.

Born by a vision to further reach into the community with the Word of God, Pastors Kevin and Kim, directors of the Ranch of Hope ministry for teens, began to follow the voice of the Lord to prepare for the opening of a congregational ministry to their area.

Over the course of a few years, the plans were laid and a building was provided by the miracle working power of God. Now after just a few months of services, the congregation is growing and reaching the families of the Williamstown area with the love and gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Full Gospel Assemblies, Domestic Missions, has made a one year commitment for \$100.00 per month for ministry support for this pioneering congregation. Our prayer is that the Lord will afford the opportunity for Full Gospel Assemblies to take on many more such missions, providing a stipend assistance for new and pioneering ministry within the Fellowship.

Traveling 30 miles each night, the Palmer's are shining the light of God's word in religious, gospel hardened area that is also steeped in witchcraft.
